| This program runs for the duration of one year. |
| Adopters will put eyes on each of their adopted lots at the beginning and throughout each program year. If any lot, or portion of, has development started or has been sold, the lot will immediately become ineligible for the AAL Program. Failure to report changes in a timely manner could result in monies due back to the City. |
